Sam Houston State University, with a student population of 30,000, has begun the Biology Laboratory building project which will provide space for research and teaching. The 83,000 square foot structure, with a Total Project Cost of \$65m, will be constructed on a 2.85-acre site and will extend what is becoming a “science corridor” on the campus.

Construction began August, 2016, and will complete in April, 2018, with classes starting in the summer session. This new state of the art building will provide space for the Department of Biological Sciences to attract and hire additional researchers as well as consolidate their groups from various buildings on campus. The design provides space for collaboration and interaction between professors and students as well as to inspire students and enhance the overall university.
