The Spur 1966 project in El Paso is a connection between Schuster Avenue on the UTEP campus and Paisano Drive via a bridge over Interstate 10. The project is approximately 0.7 miles in length and allows improved connections and traffic flow between the UTEP Campus, surrounding medical facilities and business and Mesa Street via Paisano Drive. It also creates an additional direct route to and from the downtown area.

The project accommodates vehicular, pedestrian and bicycle traffic and eliminates the need for UTEP-bound traffic to cut through the adjacent Sunset Heights and Kern Place neighborhoods to access the University facility.

ECM led the utility relocation effort during the design and continued support & coordination through the construction. ECM was the local design team representative assisting the project in the answering of RFI's, Submittals, and other contract documents.
