Over a 10-year period, an ECM International and Gilbane Building Company joint-venture provided Construction Manager at Risk services for several districts in the El Paso area. Socorro ISD's El Dorado High School was the largest of the school projects.

This facility features striking 635-foot sweeping radius walls, multiple ceiling elevations, two stories of classrooms with elevator and open bay stair access, chemical top laboratories with instructional science and experiment preparation rooms, a large band room adjacent to an Orchestra room, art classrooms, a modern dance room, locker rooms, showers and dressing facilities, rounded out by hi-tech media retrieval and independently supplied and controlled HVAC units for each of the 86 classrooms.

Athletics boasts a 21,000 sq. ft. gymnasium with practice courts, and a main court with motorized, retractable bleacher seating. Adjacent to the main gym are locker rooms, restrooms, concessions and ticket sales. Outside, there is a fully sodded and irrigated football field surrounded by a nine-lane running track, triple and long jump. A major league sized baseball field, a softball field and six lighted tennis and basketball courts.
